

Letter from International Organization for Standardization (ISSN)

Dear Mr Gogmachadze ,

The ISSN (International Standard Serial Number) is the internationally standardized identifier for serials and other continuing resources on any medium. The resources eligible for an ISSN assignment are bibliographic resources issued over time with no predetermined conclusion.

As soon as registered, the assigned ISSN and other identifying elements are recorded in an international data base, the ISSN Register, which contains more than 1,000,000 records.

We have visited your website and I am pleased to inform you that your online serial has been recorded in the ISSN Register as follows:

According to the ISO standard on ISSN, the ISSN number must be printed prominently on the title screen or homepage of your publication, preceded by the letters ISSN.

Other changes such as the publisher's name, place of publication (town / country of publication), frequency, URL ... do not affect the ISSN, but we wish to be kept informed (with the appropriate photocopies) so that we may update the bibliographic data in our records

May I draw your attention to the fact that distinct ISSN have to be assigned if different versions of your serial such as print, CD-Rom, etc. are published?
